RESOLUTION NO. 061725-2

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOLDENVILLE PUBLIC WORKS AUTHORITY, AMENDING THE CURRENT WATER, SEWER AND GARBAGE RATES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE JULY

Whereas the Holdenville Public Works Authority is charged with billing and collecting for the consumption of water and collection of sewage and garbage by and from the customers of the City of Holdenville; and

WHEREAS the Trustees believe it is also necessary to keep pace with inflation, to improve the condition of our infrastructure, to replace as necessary failing equipment, and equally important to better care for the employees who work diligently to provide the best services to the citizens and customers of the City of Holdenville and the Holdenville Public Works Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED BY THE TRUSTEES OF THE HOLDENVILLE PUBLIC WORKS AUTHORITY for the use and benefit of the City of Holdenville, Oklahoma, that the rates for the treatment and production of water and the collection and treatment of sewer and collection of garbage shall be as follows:

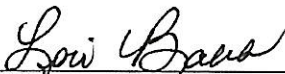
