A representative from German Roofing presented his findings. There are multiple layers up to 6 inches on the flat roof and most were wet and damaged, there were also trees growing on top of the roof. The metal roof also needs replacing. The City Attorney would like to find out who is liable for the payment to replace the roof. Mike Dockrey made a motion to approve getting bids for the replacement of the roof, and Tammy White seconded the motion.

City Manager met with DEQ and the city was on track with the DEQ improvements. Credit for task D is on consent order. City Manager proposed to use utility rate management software from Waterworth, to help with future projects and long term financial models. 200 feet of pipe and three valves have been repaired on Burgess Street.
